CREA.RE – CALL FOR APPLICANTS:

Within CREA.RE (a) the know-how, (b) good practice and (c) policy experience in the field of creative economy will be exchanged aiming at enhancing the effectiveness of each partner's – current & future - EU Regional programmes. All results shall be accessible – by interregional dissemination activities – also outside the partnership. The partnership comprises 12 partners of 10 European countries. The project is implemented from 01 January 2010 until 31 March 2013.

The Lead Partner – Cultural Department of Regional Government Authority of Upper Austria – launches on behalf of the partnership the following call for applicants:

Title: Pool of Researchers

The researchers / experts will be major contributors to the following project activities:

- actions plans to be produced by all project partners
- local working group support to be set up by each project partner

A specific budget is available for expertise supporting the establishment of action plans and the related local working groups from 2010 to 2013: € 76.000 (including VAT and travel costs).

The researchers / experts will be available to provide assistance on an ad hoc basis on specific issues related to the implementation of the CREA.RE project.

Tasks to be performed:

- to provide specific written or oral input to the topic of CREA.RE (e. g. during workshops, meetings)
- to identify and communicate the outputs of the project (e. g. case studies)

Application procedure:

1. Submission

The applications must comprise two documents:

2. Selection

The selection should be done by the CREA.RE Steering Committee in August 2010. Selected experts will be included in the CREA.RE researcher's pool list.

3. Appointment

Project partners will address requests for researcher's / expert's support to the CREA.RE lead partner. The chosen researcher / expert will have a direct contractual relationship with the CREA.RE lead partner.

Payment:

A payment of € 650 per day (including VAT) is recommended. Travel and accommodation costs will be paid from the overall researcher's pool budget.

The integration of a researcher / expert in the CREA.RE researcher's pool does not guarantee an appointment as this depends on the decisions of the CREA.RE lead and project partners.
