Mobility of Artists and Artworks

Free movement of goods, persons and services within the European Community is an essential element of the Treaty on European Union. International exchange of experts from all branches of science and production has economic impact on Europe. If as many people as possible get to know about linguistic and cultural peculiarities of other countries while staying abroad, there is a growing chance for worldwide tolerance between the peoples. Experience abroad during school, vocational training, study or work usually improves individual career opportunities.

Travels, prolonged stays abroad, participation in conferences, seminars and network meetings can help to get to know the cultural scene of the potential partner's country and make first contacts. The European Community supports cross-border co-operations but up to date not the preparation of these joint actions. Following its new European Cultural Agenda the European Commission is actually preparing new instruments for the support of mobility.

European Funding Programmes

Promotion of mobility is integral part of most EU funding programmes and initiatives.

For example:

- ✘ **CULTURE (2007-2013)** promotes mobility of artists from all disciplines and their productions (cooperation of organisations, not individuals).
- ✘ The **Europe for Citizens** programme promotes citizens' meetings and the exchange of professionals responsible for town twinning.
- ✘ The **Lifelong Learning** Programme promotes the mobility of pupils, students, teachers and specialised staff from basic, vocational and higher education.
- ✘ The programme **Erasmus Mundus** promotes academic studies and exchange inside and outside the European Union.
- ✘ The programme **Youth in Action** promotes exchanges and stays abroad.
- ✘ The **7th Framework for Research** (in particular the action „People“) promotes the mobility of scientists.
